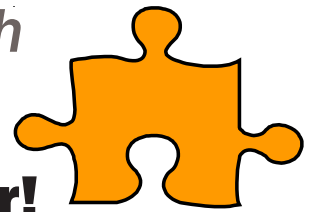


April is *Autism Awareness Month*
